THE RULES

*Teens must be entering **grades 7 and up**.*

What can I read for summer reading?

JH, YA, or adult books
Fiction or non-fiction
Audiobooks*
Graphic novels and Manga/Anime
Magazines

*Due to the pace at which audio books are read aloud, any points earned from audio books must be counted by the pages in the book (not the length of the audio book).

How does it work?

Teen patrons will keep track of the number of pages they read for each book. Please turn in your reading log(s) for every 1,000 pages during the 2010 'Summer Reading'.

Each time you turn in a reading log, you will receive either a book or a candy bar of your choice. **You can turn in your reading log(s) three times.** Once you have read past 3,000 pages, you can continue to turn in your logs for a chance at the top reader prizes, but you can no longer receive a book or a candy bar each time.

How else can I win?

By coming to our programs! For each teen library program attended, your name will be added into the drawings held throughout summer reading for a Target gift card. Drawings will take place at every teen program. Want to increase your odds of winning? You can also receive extra raffle tickets **by writing book reviews**, which will be posted to the library's teen blog (found via the library website and directly at <http://hplteen.wordpress.com>). **You can post two ways:** drop off your review at the Youth Services Desk at the library or post it yourself. If you post it yourself, you must include your active email address. You will receive an email confirming that a raffle ticket is ready for you to pick up at the Youth Services Desk. *Inappropriate post(s) will be taken down without notice.*
