Transferring VHS to DVD

Some things to note before you start your transfer:

- Copyrighted materials will be rejected by the machine. The VHS will be spat out.
- All transfers must be done in real time. i.e. Your 8 hour VHS will take 8 hours to transfer to DVD.
- We provide DVDs with 2 hours-worth of space on them. You'll need to provide your own if the VHS is longer than 2 hours.
- We won't cover editing in this lesson, but the Magnavox manual provided teaches you how to edit.
- You must finalize the DVD! It will not play on other machines if it has not been finalized.

Transfer Instructions

- 1. Insert your VHS & blank DVD into the machine.
- 2. Make sure that the machine is on VHS mode (you can hit the 'VCR' button on Magnavox remote).
- 3. Turn on the screen.
- 4. Press 'setup' on the Magnavox remote. Use the up and down arrows to select 'General Setting' on the screen. Press 'OK'.
- 5. Use up and down arrows on Magnavox remote to select 'Recording' and press 'OK'.
- 6. Select 'Dubbing Mode' with up and down arrows and press 'OK' and selection menu will appear.
- 7. Use up and down arrows on Magnavox remote to select VCR \rightarrow DVD.
- 8. Press 'setup' on Magnavox remote.
- Press 'Play' (►) on Magnavox remote and find the point where you want to start the transfer.
 Press 'Pause' (■■).
- 10. Press 'DVD' button on Magnavox remote and press the white 'Rec. Mode' button on the lower left of the remote.
- 11. Press 'D Dubbing' on Magnavox remote
 - a. You will know the VHS is recording to DVD when you see DB on the screen on the machine.
 - b. If you see wavy lines on the screen, the tracking needs to be adjusted and the buttons to do this are on the machine.
 - c. Some tapes that are older and have started to disintegrate might also have wavy lines and adjusting tracking might not fix this.
 - d. It does not matter if you have the volume down or muted while recording. The sound quality on the VHS will be recorded.
- 12. Once the VHS is done, press 'Stop'(). The recording will begin writing to the DVD.
- 13. To finalize the disc:
 - a. Press 'Stop' () and then 'setup' on the Magnavox remote.
 - b. Press 'Disc Edit' and 'OK'.
 - c. Use up and down arrows to select 'Finalize'.
 - d. The finalizing process will begin. It takes some time.
